Coaches Code of Conduct and Child Protection Policy

It is the policy of Olney Ladies Hockey Club to ensure the welfare and safety of children and young people when they are in the care of the Club. The Club will make members and parents who are involved with junior hockey fully aware of the standards we are upholding and of the measures we have in operation. The Club will provide any necessary training to members and will supervise and update the policy through the Chairwoman, Committee and Head Coach. The arrangements for implementing this policy are:

1. All Coaches to be CRB checked and Volunteers who have a position of responsibility in relation to, and/or regular contact with, young players to be CRB checked or to fill out 'Declaration Statement' (to be held in confidence by the Chairwoman for safe-keeping).
2. The Club to have a suitably qualified Child Protection Officer in addition to Head Coach. The Chairwoman, Head Coach and Child Protection Officer to have read and be aware of current child Protection safe practice guidelines.
3. All Coaches and Volunteers to be registered as members of the Club.
4. All Parents/Guardians to be made aware of Code of Conduct and Child Protection Policy and Health & Safety Policy with access to relevant documentation as required and contact names and numbers.
5. Where a player (if Under 16 or below) represents the Club at adult level, her Parent/Guardian to be informed of changing and travel arrangements and their permission.
