Parents/Guardians Code of Conduct

It is the policy of Olney Ladies Hockey Club to ensure that its Juniors learn and play hockey in the most supportive and enjoyable atmosphere possible. Parents/Guardians are therefore respectfully asked to:

1. Encourage your child to play her hockey for fun.
2. Encourage your child to learn and improve.
3. Discourage unfair play and arguing with officials.
4. Accept coaches' and umpires' decisions as final.
5. Recognise and applaud effort and application as well as results.
6. Recognise and applaud the achievements of others including opponents.
7. Not encroach on playing or practice area without the Coach in charge's permission, nor remonstrate with or criticize anyone else's daughter/ward.
8. Ensure your child arrives at practices and matches in good time and is collected promptly afterwards.
9. Encourage your child to help set up before and clear up after matches and coaching sessions.
10. Raise any concerns you may have with the Head Coach, Child Protection Officer or Chairwoman of the Club as quickly as possible.
